



**YOUTH COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:**

**2.60.040 Membership.**

- (1) The Youth Commission may consist of 9 voting members and 3 alternates appointed by the City Council.
- (2) The Commission shall serve without compensation.
- (3) Each member shall serve a term of two years. If, for any reason, a vacancy occurs during the term of a Youth Commission member, the City Council shall appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term of that Youth Commission member. The City Council may remove a Youth Commission member at any time if the City Council determines that member is not fulfilling his or her responsibilities to the satisfaction of the City Council.
- (4) Persons appointed to serve on the Commission shall reside within the City of Federal Way city limits, attend high school within the city limits, or attend a high school that is part of the Federal Way Public School District.
- (5) The City Council will encourage applications to serve on the commission so, as much as practicable, members may reflect a diverse cross-section of students in the community. Freshman, sophomores, juniors, and seniors are eligible.
- (6) The Youth Commission is operational in accordance with the Federal Way School District Calendar.
